We were struggling with scours in our two 2400 sow farms when Jorn Siedenfaden from the Enviroguard Company contacted me about Stalosan F. The scours had increased to the point where we were treating every pig on day one and still having up to thirty percent of the litters break with scours day two or three. I decided to try Stalosan F on one of the sow farms. I was amazed at the immediate and nearly total elimination of scours in the treated rooms. Within two weeks we were able to discontinue the day one scour shot and had only two to three percent of the litters that needed treatment on day two or three. As a double check of Stalosan F's effectiveness, we left one row of crates in f farrowing room untreated while using only Stalosan F on the other two rows. Within three days of farrowing half of the litters in the untreated crates were scouring while no litters in the Stalosan F crates scoured. We've been using Stalosan F on both sow farms for three months now and have also seen a significant reduction in strep problems in our nurseries. I would highly recommend Stalosan F to anyone struggling with scours or strep.
