Stalosan F

Dr. Darwin Reicks and the vets at the Swine Vet Center have used Stalosan F as a sanitizing agent. " Stalosan F is a useful sanitizing and drying agent. We've had good luck with it in the farrowing crates, especially with reducing scours caused by coccidia. It has a pleasant odor, and the farm staff feel it has been effective. We used it on a field trial basis on a 2500 sow farm that was being challenged by coccidia scours at 7-14 days of age. Half of each room received Stalosan application daily to the mats. This started on day 3 or 4 of age and continued to weaning. There was a marked reduction in the incidence of scours where the Stalosan F was used. We've also used it on an individual animal basis for adult swine. Sporadic looseness in sows or boars can often be difficult to resolve. The Stalosan F placed in the animals environment has been effective when traditional treatments have not. We had a farm that had sporadic looseness for some time. An enteric Salmonella was identified, but response to traditional antibiotics was poor. 85 % needed retreatment and a high percentage of these were non-responsive. 31 of these received Stalosan, administered topically to their environment. Only 7 required treatment and with < 10 % non-responders. The farm now uses Stalosan as a part of their treatment regime."
